Mission: To provide a range of supportive services and housing that empowers homeless families, who are survivors of domestic violence or other trauma, to become independent, self-sufficient, and adequately housed; and to foster housing opportunities to prevent homelessness and encourage safe, affordable housing.

HEARTH'S IMPACT ON HOMELESSNESS

- Stability is an essential component of our program; 21% of homeless children repeat a grade because of frequent absence from school, compared to 5% of other children.
- Education and job skill training are the critical resources needed to lift families out of poverty and homelessness. Each HEARTH participant must enroll in a post-secondary education or training program.
- HEARTH provides life skills training, which includes: budgeting, parenting skills, and coping skills.
- HEARTH's program stops the cycle of poverty by instilling essential skills that our participants will teach their children. HEARTH's program provides an intergenerational change. It is the bridge homeless families need to help work towards economic mobility.
- HEARTH addresses substantial housing insecurities by providing access to essential resources, including a food pantry, clothing pantry, health services, transportation, and weekly case management sessions.
- HEARTH's program works! 81% of our program participants obtained permanent housing after completing our transitional housing program.
